**Sub: Request for relaxation in delivery of additional 10%
Oscsc CMR to FCI during the KMS 2014-15.**

Most respectfully, we draw your kind attention to the upward revision of delivery percentage of Oscsc CMR to FCI by 10% for Khariff season. This has put the millers of most of the districts in problem and there is wide spread discontentment amongst them.

This increase was made about 3 month after the Khariff procurement was over. Moreover, apart from initial fixation of FCI delivery ratio during 1st week of April, 2015, *some districts were already subjected to an increase of 5 to 15% in the intervening period vide Fscw Letter Nos.8081 Dt.23.4.15 and 9595 Dt.18.5.15.* Millers are facing more financial hardship due to this additional delivery of 10% to FCI in view of the financial implications involved. Raw Rice producing districts like Koraput, Raygada, Malkangiri, Gajapati and Ganjam are the worst sufferer. *After an all time record acceptance of rice, FCI too has come to a saturation point and delivery of CMR is affected.* We understand that some relaxation has already been granted to Koraput and Jagatsingpur districts.

We therefore, most humbly request your honour to *kindly consider withdrawal of the additional delivery of 10% in full for the raw rice producing districts and allowing relaxation in delivery for all other district by at least 7% for Khariff season to mitigate the problem of the millers to some extent.* Hope, your honour will be kind enough to consider our request sympathetically.
