Sub: Fixation of district wise ratio for delivery of CMR to FCI on account of Oscsc during KMS 2013-14.

This is in continuation of our earlier submissions on discussions and views expressed by members during our Association Meeting held on 11.11.2013 at Bhubaneswar. Almost all the members across various districts were concerned and apprehensive about damage to the paddy crop during recent untimely rains and floods. There is every chance of substantial increase in the percentage of immature, sprouted, damage and discolored grains in paddy which will be coming to the market. The quality of resultant rice is also likely to be affected making it difficult to meet the requirements of specifications and subsequent delivery to FCI.

We therefore most humbly suggest that before fixation of any ratio for delivery of CMR to FCI, prima-facie quality assessment of the milled rice from current crop may be carried out in different districts with the help of technical team of FCI and GOI to ascertain the extent of damage and acceptability of rice by FCI. A proper assessment can only help better compliance of instructions as well as smooth paddy procurement.
